

## How to say Yes, No, Maybe, Don't

Yes - Oo

No - Dili or Wala (nothing/ it's not)

Maybe - Basin (Ba-sin)

Don't - Ayaw

Here are some open-ended example sentences:

Example 1:

Ganahan ka ug Humba?

Do you like Humba (Filipino dish)?

*Ganahan – like*

*Ka -you*

*Ug – connecting word*

*Answer: O (Yes) / Dili (No)*

Example 2.

Ayaw ko hikapa.

Don't touch me.

*Ayaw – don't*

*Ko – me*

*Hikapa - touch*

Example 3.

Makig-date ka nako?

Would you want to date me?

Basin. (Maybe)

*Makig-date – to go out on a date*

*Ka – you*

*Nako - me*

Example 4.

Basin moulan karon.

Maybe, it will rain today.

*Basin – maybe*

*Moulan – will rain*

*Karon – now/ today*

Example 5.

Nag-ulan dinha?

Is it raining there?

Answer: O (Yes) / Wala (It's not)

*Nag-ulan – raining/ rained*

*Dinha - there*
