Farewell

"Manamilit nako."

Filipino/Tagalog: Paalam na.

Goodbye

"babay, bay-bay, baboosh"

Filipino/Tagalog: Paalam.

I'm going.

"Adto nako" or "Adto sa ko"

"Ari nako" or "Ari sa ko"

"Manamilit na ko" is somewhat the nearest translation I could think of but this phrase is not usually used by locals. When this phrase is used it's like you are dying or you are going to die.

Locals sometimes used this to sound comic with friends but the following phrases are more commonly used to say good bye to friends or family:

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"Adto nako" or "Adto sa ko"
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which simply means "I'm going"

"Uli nako" means "I'm going home"
